



- d) 'Applicant' or 'Tenderer' or 'Bidder' means the person submitting the Tender pursuant to the Notice Inviting Tender.
- e) "Committee" means Tender and Purchase Committee
- f) "Chairman" is the Chairman of the Tender & Purchase Committee, SMCH, Silchar
- g) "Term" means the term commencing from the Commencement Date, until the termination of the rate contract awarded to the successful bidder to supply of **annexure A mentioned Elisa Kits** to the Office of the Principal cum Chief Superintendent.


## 2. TERMS & CONDITIONS

### a. Eligibility and Qualifications

1. Any registered Manufacturer / Authorized dealer / Distributor / Firm / Vendor having **valid trade license** (Copy to be attached with annexure-1)
2. Proven ability and experience of **one year** of supplying **annexure A mentioned Elisa Kits** to Govt., Semi-Govt. Organisation or PSU (proof to be attached with annexure-1)

  
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3. **GST Registration** and proof of filing GST Return for any month of the year 2021. Proof of return filed before 2021 shall not be accepted (proof to be attached with annexure-1)
4. **PAN** of the Proprietor/ Manufacturer / Authorized dealer / Distributor / Vendor (copy to be attached with annexure-1)
5. **Not blacklisted** by any Government Departments for any type of contract, be it Elisa Kits or others.

**b. Mandatory Requirements on the part of the bidder**

i. Form 16 or ITR Acknowledgement Form 26AS of Income Tax

Department of India of Financial Year 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 (any deviation from this will disqualify the submitted tender document) -

ii. Declaration on non-judicial stamp paper of 50/- duly attested by Notary Public to the effect that the Applicant is not barred or black- listed on any Government Department or public sector Undertaking - Original copy to be attached. Submission of photocopy will disqualify the tender.

iv. Detailed Statement of Bank account showing balance of September, October and November, 2021 to be attached failing which the submitted tender will be summarily rejected.

v. A self-certified Certificate of furnishing correct information is to be submitted by the bidder to the effect that correct information has been furnished in the Tender and the Applicant shall be solely responsible for furnishing misleading, wrong or false information in the Tender. Furnishing of misleading, wrong or false information if detected by the Committee will lead to the rejection of the submitted tender document.


**c. Earnest Money Deposit**


Tenderer shall furnish along with their tender an Earnest Money Deposit of **Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand only)** in the form of Demand Draft/ Bankers Cheque in favour of "**Hospital Management Society, Silchar Medical College & Hospital, Silchar**" payable at Silchar. The EMD should be put inside the envelope meant for "Part-1: Technical Bid". Earnest money in any other form of cash or Cheque shall not be accepted.

***Tender not accompanied by the EMD shall be summarily rejected on the day of opening the tender document itself***

Earnest Money Deposit of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned on written application mentioning the Draft/Bankers Cheque No. without interest after the finalization of the tender

  
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Bidders are advised to keep photocopy of the EMD Draft with them.

**d. Price Schedule and Payment Terms**

Tenderers should quote rate of each Item without fail in the Annexure II (Financial Bid) of the Tender Document (**Bidder should quote rate as per table format given in Annexure II**). If the rate of a particular item of Elisa Kit is not filled up, the tender document shall not be considered for comparative evaluation.

The Rates should be quoted for single unit price.

The Chairman, Tender & Purchase Committee is not bound to accept the lowest bid or any tender and also reserves the right to reject all or any of the tender without assigning any reason.

**e. Terms of Delivery**

All the Items should be delivered free of cost at the Store of the establishment of Principal cum Chief Superintendent, Silchar Medical College & Hospital, Silchar, Assam-788014

**f. Delivery Period**

The Items should be supplied within 15 days (including holidays) from the date of issue of Purchase order. The delivery shall be through Parcel/Courier/in person on the risk and responsibility of the firm. No postage, Insurance or any other charges whatsoever extra shall be paid.

**g. Penalty Clause**


i. For delays: - If the supplier fails to supply the Items as per purchase order within the time period specified in the contract, the purchaser shall deduct from contract price/EMD a sum equivalent to 0.5% of the price of delayed items for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery up to a maximum of 10(ten) percent. Once the maximum is reached, the purchaser may consider termination of the contract.


ii. Termination of default: - The purchaser may, without prejudice to any other remedy or breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, terminate the contract in whole or part if the supplier fails to deliver any or all items ordered to him within the time period specified in the contract, or if the supplier fails to perform other obligation(S) under the contract. In the event of the termination of the contract by **SMCH, Silchar**, Cachar in whole or in part, the SMCH, Silchar, Cachar may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate the undelivered Items and the supplier shall be liable to pay for any excess cost for such purchases. However, the supplier shall continue performance of the contract to the extent not terminated.

iii. Force majeure: - The supplier shall not be liable for (a) and (b) above, if its delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the contract is the result of an event of force majeure

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(Means an event beyond the control of the supplier and not involving the supplier's fault or negligence and not foreseeable). Such events may include, but not restricted to, acts of the purchaser either in its sovereign or contractual capacity, wars or revolution, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargo. The supplier shall promptly notify the purchase of such conditions and the causes.

- h. The Tender & Purchase Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any tender or the whole tendering process and reject any or all tenders with valid justification at any time prior to award of the contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidders or any obligations to inform the affected Bidders of the grounds for the Committee's decision.

### 3. RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

In case of a dispute or difference arising between supplier and purchaser relating to any matter arising out of or connected with the contract, such dispute or difference shall be referred to the sole Arbitrator duly appointed by The "Hospital Management Society, Silchar Medical College & Hospital, Silchar". The award of the arbitrator shall be binding to the parties concern.

### 4. SUBMISSION OF TENDER DOCUMENT

Tenderer should submit the tender in two separate sealed envelopes as detailed below.

**Envelope No. 1 (Documents):** The 1<sup>st</sup> envelope clearly marked as "Part-1 : Technical Bid" shall contain the following documents:

1. Demand Draft/Bankers Cheque for the EMD
2. Fully filled & signed (wherever necessary) tender document with all necessary enclosures. Enclosures should be as per the check list

**Envelope No.2: (Tender/Financial Bid):** The 2nd envelope marked as "Part-2: Financial Bid" shall contain only the price quote. The tenderer should quote his offer as per Annexure-II

**He / She should not quote his offer anywhere directly or indirectly in Envelope No. 1**


The envelope no. 1 & envelope no. 2 shall again be put together in one common envelope and sealed. This final sealed envelope cover shall be marked as "TENDER FOR Elisa Kits Required at VRDL, SMCH, Silchar".

The **full name and address, phone number and E.Mail id** of the tenderer submitting the tender shall be written on the final envelope. If submitted by Post, the sealed envelope marked as above shall be enclosed in another cover properly addressed and shall be sent by Registered Speed Post. The Tenders

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must be submitted to Office of the Principal cum Chief Superintendent, Silchar Medical College & Hospital, Silchar, Assam-788014.

The date and time for the receipt of envelope containing tender shall strictly apply in all cases. The tenderer should ensure that their tender is received by the Office of the Superintendent, Silchar Medical College & Hospital, Silchar, Assam-788014 before the expiry of the date and time as scheduled. No delays on account of any cause will be entertained for the late receipt of the tender. Tender offered or received after expiry of the date and time will either not be accepted or if inadvertently accepted will not be opened and shall be returned to the tenderer unopened.

## **5. OPENING OF TENDERS**

Following procedure shall be adopted for the opening of Tenders:

**Envelope No. 1:** First of all, Envelope No. 1 of the tender will be opened on the date and time as scheduled to verify its contents as per the requirement. If the various documents contained in this envelope do not meet the requirements, a note will be recorded accordingly by the committee and the said tenderer's Envelope No.2 will not be considered for further action. All the bidders or their representatives must be present at the time of opening the "**Technical Bid**" of the tender document. No claim of any kind will be entertained from a bidder who does not remain present at the time of opening the bidding. After opening the bidding documents, all the bidders will be allowed access to the bidding document of each other one by one. Any objections raised by a bidder against another bidder / bidders on any aspect of the bidding document has to be submitted in written only to addressed to the Chairman or Member Secretary of the Tender & Purchase Committee before 04.00 pm of the next working day. No objection of any kind will be documented by the committee on the date of opening the tender.




## **6. SELECTION OF SUCCESSFUL BIDDER**

- a. Both quality and Price will be taken into account while selecting the successful bidder. So the right to choose the successful bidder lies with the Tender & Purchase Committee and not necessarily the lowest bidder in Financial Bid.
- b. Although selection as per procedure is on lowest quoted basis from technically qualified vendors, the committee solely reserves the right to select the successful bidder.
- c. **The committee, if desires may take suggestion from competent authority in deciding the successful bidder but the suggestion given by those authorities shall not be binding on the**

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committee. The decision taken by the committee in selecting the successful bidder will be final and the same will be recommended to the Principal cum- chief Superintendent for award of contract. However, the recommendation made by the committee shall not be binding on the Principal cum- chief Superintendent, SMCH. The Principal cum- chief superintendent may accept or summarily reject the recommendation made by the committee and take steps as he may deem fit as per rules.


d. The committee reserves the right to decide whether to take any suggestion from any other competent authority.

7. **WARNING. Canvassing in any form either verbal, written, telephonic call or third party approach etc. to chairman, member secretary or any of the members of the Tender & Purchase Committee will be a disqualification. The committee does not want to receive any recommendation letter or any forwarding in any official stationary or personal letter of any Govt. or Non-Govt. authority or Individual in any stage of the tendering process till award of the final contract. In case, a bidder is found to be submitting such recommendation document either directly to the committee or through the College or Hospital Authority of Silchar Medical College, Silchar at any stage of the tendering process, the committee will summarily reject his tender document.**
